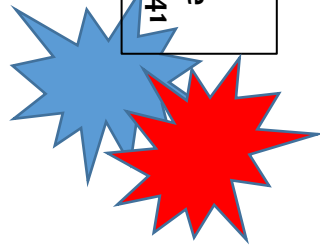

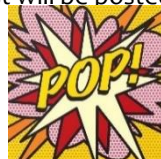
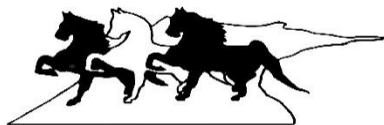

RULES AND REGULATIONS

REFUNDS

Any decision to make refunds for stall rent or entry fees will be at the discretion of show management.

CALLS FOR CLASSES

Every effort will be made to keep the barns aware of what is happening in the show ring. However, it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to be prepared to enter the ring when called. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring before the gate is closed. **All gate holds must be declared prior to the start of each performance and the gate crew must be notified when the rider is ready to enter the ring. Once a hold is announced it will not be cancelled.**

SCRATCHES

Each exhibitor must officially scratch entries in any event they choose not to participate in.

REPLACEMENT OF SHOES AND EQUIPMENT

An exhibitor is entitled to request one suspension of judging for a period not to exceed five minutes in order to repair broken equipment, replace a shoe or rectify a similar situation.

PERSONNEL ALLOWED IN THE RING

No one except show officials will be allowed in the ring during a class. Exceptions to this would include headers and those who are invited to participate.

JUDGING CONSIDERATIONS

USEF Rules and judging specifications will apply.

Arrival and Departure

Arrival: Friday, August 20, not before 12:00 Noon

Departure: Sunday, August 22

Absolutely no stabling can be provided before the specified arrival date or after the departure date. Our Simon's contract prohibits the modification of these dates in any way by Show Management.

Stabling

Stalls are permanent box stalls with sliding doors and vary in size from a minimum of 8x8. All stabling must be made and paid with entries in advance. All horses entered in the show must have a stall. There are a limited number of double stalls for \$180.00. Stabling facilities may not be altered in any way. **All damages to stalls necessitating repair charges will be billed to the occupants.**

Stall occupancy will be \$90 for the entire show. Tack stalls will also be \$90 for the entire show. If you are only attending one day, stalls will be \$75.00. All horses must be stabled.

Bedding

There will not be complimentary first bedding. Shavings must be ordered at the time of stall reservations. Shavings are **\$10.00** per bag. During the show, bedding orders may be placed in the Horse Show office and will be delivered by Simon's personnel.

The show office will be open 2:00-7:00 pm Friday. The office will open at 8:00 am Saturday and Sunday and will close one hour prior to each performance. Dinner break to be posted each day. As a courtesy, please have all entries paid in full by 12:00 noon on Sunday. Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it is subject to the rules and regulations of the **POP UP HORSE SHOW**. Exhibitor, trainer and/or owner shall make all entries and no animal will be admitted for exhibition until exhibitor, trainer or owner signs the entry blank.

General Information

ARENA Hours – The arena will be open at noon on Friday. It will be available for your use up to one hour prior to show time on Saturday and Sunday. At other times, the warm-up area will be available for use at the east end of the arena.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Veterinary Examinations and Minnesota State Health Requirements:

All horses on the grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds by order of the official veterinarian. Horses originating from outside Minnesota must be accompanied by an Interstate Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian within thirty (30) days prior to exhibition identifying each horse and certifying that it free, insofar as can be determined, from infectious disease. A negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia within twelve (12) months and proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccination within six (6) months of entering the stable or fairgrounds must accompany each horse. These documents must be recorded by the office personnel for each horse brought onto the fairgrounds.

An official veterinarian will be designated to make inspections and rulings in all cases where the opinion of a veterinarian is required. No one shall approach a veterinarian with regard to his decision unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the veterinarian at the proper time and place.

A licensed veterinarian will be on the grounds. Contact information for the vet is Dr. Winstead Kirkpatrick 612-865-6355.

Medical Waste: Competition management shall place at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing show horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individual(s) including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

ACADEMY CLASSES AND ATTIRE

CLASS INFORMATION

OPEN PERFORMANCE: Mane & tail may be trimmed, set or natural. To be shown at a walk, trot or pleasure gait and canter, on a reasonably loose rein. Horses are judged on manners, performance and suitability to pleasure riding. May be shown in any other division for which they are qualified.

LIMIT RIDER CLASSES: Rider who has not won 3 firsts in that division. Classes are open to all breeds.

OPEN PLEASURE PROSPECT ANY AGE: To be shown in a snaffle or full bridle at a flat walk, trot and canter.

COMBINING OR SPLITTING OF CLASSES – Management reserves the right to combine or split any classes (age divisions) should this be in the best interest of all participants. **ALL CHANGES OR CLASS ADDITIONS WILL BE POSTED IN THE SHOW OFFICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.**



NEW – SAFETY HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL AGE RIDERS

The Academy Division is intended for riders who are taking lessons and are mounted on horses that are owned or leased by a riding school or instructor. **Saddle Seat Riders:** Jodhpurs or dark long pants, dress shirt, tie, riding type boots. **Hunt Seat Riders:** Breeches or jods, ratcatcher shirt. **Western:** Jeans and dress shirt. Vests, sweater vests or sweaters are optional. Hair neat, up and out of the way of the exhibitor's number.

The Open Schooling Division is for the novice or beginner exhibitor who isn't ready to compete in classes where full show attire is required. Riders may show their own horse, a leased horse or an Academy horse. Open to riders of any age. No show attire is allowed. Neatness turn-out of horse and rider to be considered in all classes. Classes may be split by age. At shows, cross entry if permitted between Open Schooling Division and classes requiring full show attire with a different rider/handler. Entry restrictions apply only to year end nominations. See Tri-State spec for details. Safety helmets are required.

ENTRIES FOR ACADEMY

The order of classes may vary from the posted schedule in this book. The class order will be determined once entries have been received and those participants who will be sharing horses are accommodated. A final class order will be available in the Horse Show Office prior to each Academy session.

You must have your academy entries entered Friday night and Saturday night.

Effective February 4, 2019, any individual that appears on the Safe Sport or USEF banned or suspended lists cannot be in attendance, compete or participate in such competition in any manner, including as a trainer, coach, owner or exhibitor of horses or ponies.
