RULES AND REQULATIONS

REFUNDS

Any decision to make refunds for stall rent or entry fees will be at the discretion of show management.

CALLS FOR CLASSES

Every effort will be made to keep the barns aware of what is happening in the show ring. However, it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to be prepared to enter the ring when called. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring before the gate is closed. All gate holds must be declared prior to the start of each performance and the gate crew must be notified when the rider is ready to enter the ring. Once a hold is announced it will not be cancelled.

SCRATCHES

Each exhibitor must officially scratch entries in any event they choose not to participate in.

REPLACEMENT OF SHOES AND EQUIPMENT

An exhibitor is entitled to request suspension of judging for a period not to exceed five minutes in order to repair broken equipment, replace a shoe or rectify a similar situation.

PERSONNEL ALLOWED IN THE RING

No one except show officials will be allowed in the ring during a class. Exception to this would include headers and those who are invited to participate.

JUDGING CONSIDERATIONS

USEF Rules and judging specifications will apply

Arrival and Departure

Arrival: Friday, July 17, not before 10:00 am Departure: Sunday, July 19

Stabling

Stalls are permanent box stalls with sliding doors and vary in size from a minimum of 10 X 10 to 12 X 12. All stabling must be made and paid with entries in advance. All horses entered in the show must have a stall. Stabling facilities may not be altered in any way. All damages to stalls necessitating repair charges will be billed to the occupants.

Stall occupancy will be \$90 for the entire show. Tack stalls will also be \$90 for the entire show. If you are only attending one day, stalls will be \$75.00. All horses must be stabled.

Bedding

All shavings used on the grounds must be purchased through Minnesota Equestrian Center with your entry form. Pre-purchased shavings will be delivered to your stall for \$8.00 per bag. A minimum of 2 bags must be purchased per horse stall. During the show, bedding orders may be placed in the show office. No straw is allowed as bedding. Camping

Camper Hook-Ups are available at the Minnesota Equestrian Center. They are designated on a first come basis at \$75.00 per spot, sign up on the entry form for your camper hook up. You must come into the Horse Show Office to pickup a registration sticker to be placed on the windshield or door of your camper. There are plenty of hook ups throughout the grounds.

Exhibitor, trainer and/or owner shall make all entries and no animal will be admitted for exhibition until exhibitor, trainer or owner signs the entry blank.



Minnesota Equestrian Center is located about 100-150 miles southeast of the Twin Cities. Madison Wisconsin is located about 160 miles southeast of the Minnesota Equestrian Center.

Follow Hwy 52 south to Rochester; take I-90 East to Winona. Take exit 252, which is Hwy 43 North, turn left, go about 1.5 miles to Cty Rd 21 or Gilmore Valley Road, go left to the arena.

Coming from Hwy 61, at the intersection of Hwy 61 & Hwy 43 follow the signs to I-90 West, go about 5 miles to Cty. Rd 21 or Gilmore Valley Road, turn right to arena.

Coming from southern Wisconsin go I-90 West through La Crosse into Minnesota to exit 252, Hwy 43 North. Turn right, go 1.5 miles to Cty Road 21 or Gilmore Valley Road. Turn left to arena.



Minnesota Equestrian Center Area and Grounds Rules and Regulations

All posted parking and traffic restrictions will be in full force.

No cats are allowed, and all dogs must be on a leash.

Obey the NO SMOKING restrictions.

All manure from daily cleaning must be put in the designated areas. Shavings are not allowed in the barn aisles.

SHOW ARENA AND WARM UP AREA

The show arena is 100' x 210' and the footing consists of dirt and sand. There is an 80' x 130' indoor warm up area, the footing consists of sand.

STABLING FACILITIES MAY NOT BE ALTERED

The use of nails or staples on the stalls or woodwork is not acceptable. A \$50.00 charge will be applied to your entry form if found used. Please comply with this rule.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Veterinary Examinations and Minnesota State Health Requirements:

All horses on the grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds by order of the official veterinarian. Horses originating from outside Minnesota must be accompanied by an Interstate Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian within thirty (30)days prior to exhibition identifying each horse and certifying that it free, insofar as can be determined, from infectious disease. A negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia within twelve (12)months and proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccination within six (6)months of entering the stable or fairgrounds must accompany each horse. These documents must be recorded by the office personnel for each horse brought onto the fairgrounds.

An official veterinarian will be designated to make inspections and rulings in all cases where the opinion of a veterinarian is required. No one shall approach a veterinarian with regard to her decision unless he/she first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the veterinarian at the proper time and place.

A licensed veterinarian will be on call and has 24 hour emergency services. Contact information for Bluff Country Equine in Winona is 507-452-8665.

Medical Waste: Competition management shall place at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing show horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individual(s) including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.





CLASS INFORMATION

OPEN PERFORMANCE: Mane & tail may be trimmed, set or natural. To be shown at a walk, trot or pleasure gait and canter, on a reasonably loose rein. Horses are judged on manners, performance and suitability to pleasure riding. May be shown in any other division for which they are qualified.

LIMIT RIDER CLASSES: Rider who has not won 6 firsts in that division. Classes are open to all breeds.

FIRST SUIT CLASS: Riders competing at first regular show (non-Academy) in full show attire.

COMBINING OR SPLITTING OF CLASSES – Management reserves the right to combine or split any classes (age divisions) should this be in the best interest of all participants. ALL CHANGES OR CLASS ADDITIONS WILL BE POSTED IN THE SHOW OFFICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.



ACADEMY CLASSES AND ATTIRE

The Academy Division is intended for riders who are taking lessons and are mounted on horses that are owned or leased by a riding school or instructor. Saddle Seat Riders: Jodhpurs or dark long pants, dress shirt, tie, riding type boots. Hunt Seat Riders: Breeches or jods, ratcatcher shirt. Western: Jeans and dress shirt. Vests, sweater vests or sweaters are optional. Hair neat, up and out of the way of the exhibitor's number. SAFETY HELMETS ARE ALLOWED AND ENCOURAGED.

ENTRIES FOR ACADEMY

The order of classes may vary from the posted schedule in this book. The class order will be determined once entries have been received and those participants who will be sharing horses are accommodated. A final class order will be available in the Horse Show Office prior to each Academy session. You must have your academy entries entered Friday night and Saturday night.

Midwest Breeders 3 and 4-Year Old Under Saddle Jackpot Class

Open to 3 and 4-year olds that are bred by a resident of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois or Iowa, as indicated on the entry's registration papers.

Entries may cross enter into other classes in the show provided they meet the appropriate class requirements. Open to eligible registered American Saddlebred stallions, mares or geldings. Entries may be shown in set or unset tails and with or without trimmed manes. Entry shall be shown at the flat or animated walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, stand and back readily. Entries may be show in a snaffle or full bridle.

Entry: \$200 entry fee. Minnesota Saddlebred Horse Association will add \$50 per entry to jackpot. 100% jackpot paid out.

1st-30%; 2nd-25%; 3rd-20%; 4th-15%; 5th-7%; 6th-3%

Any unplaced money will be divided equally between place entries.

Effective February 4, 2019, any individual that appears on the Safe Sport or USEF banned or suspended lists cannot be in attendance, compete or participate in such competition in any manner, including as a trainer, coach, owner or exhibitor of horses or ponies.
